Notification of road works on the A42 southbound at M1 junction 23a / A453

I am writing to let you know about essential survey works on the A42 southbound carriageway in the area of the M1 junction 23a / A453 Finger Farm Island.

When will the work take place?

The work will take place between **Thursday 30 May and Friday 31 May.**

Please note that all our planned roadworks are subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

How will the work affect traffic?

To minimise inconvenience and disruption to the travelling public we will work **overnight from 8pm to 6am.**

To maintain a safe environment for our workforce and road users, we will need to use a mixture of closures:

- full closure of the entry slip road on the A42 southbound carriageway from the A453 Finger Farm Island
- full closure of the entry slip road on the M1 southbound carriageway at junction 23a
- lane closures on the M1 southbound carriageway from the exit slip road at junction 23a onto the A42

During our works, we will put in place fully signed diversion routes which have been agreed with the local authority. The diversion routes will be:

- Motorway permitted traffic heading towards the A42 or M1 southbound should follow the A453 northbound to the M1 at junction 24. Then follow the M1 southbound to junction 23a where drivers can either join the A42 or continue along the M1

- Motorway prohibited traffic heading towards the A42 should follow the A453 westbound at Finger Farm Island to Tonge. Drivers can then join the A42 at junction 14 (Tonge)

We politely ask all heavy vehicles to follow the M1 diversion route which will help minimise the overnight disturbance experienced by communities in the surrounding area.

We apologise for any inconvenience caused and will do our very best to complete the work as quickly as possible.

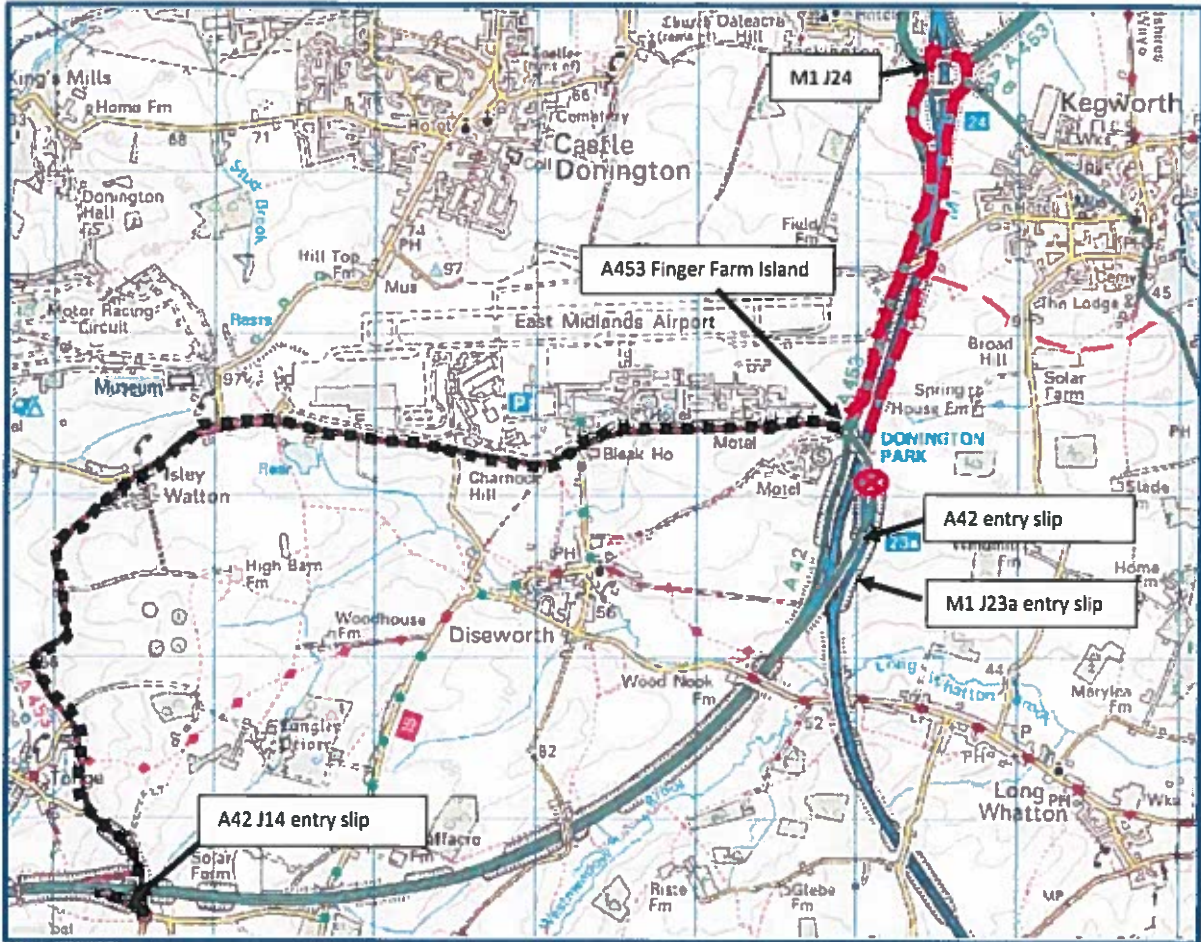
